Parade Rules Regulations and Policies

- 1. Completed and signed parade application must be received by November 15, 2019.
- 2. Indemnification forms must be signed by every participating organization and returned with your parade application.
- 3. The City of Collinsville Christmas in Collinsville/Christmas at the Collins House Committee adopts and amends the rules and regulations.
- 4. Parade may be limited to the first 50 entries. Themed/decorated floats will be given priority with minimal cars permitted. All entries must have Christmas lights, light up décor, and/or Christmas themed display. We asked that you do not have anyone dressed up like Santa on your float since we have the "real" Santa at the end of the parade (would not want to confuse the little kids with multiples).
- 5. Each entry is limited to one motor vehicle.
- 6. All participants in the parade must abide by all rules, regulations, and decisions set forth by the Committee.
- 7. The theme for the parade is Christmas in Collinsville be creative.
- 8. Floats will be judged on appropriateness to the theme, appeal, originality, and overall effect. Float prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners TBD. Judging will take place during parade.
- 9. **Candy may not be thrown from the vehicles/floats.** However, parade walkers may hand out items to watchers.
- 10. The parade will start at Combs and Main Street (in front of the Collins House). It will go down Main Street to Center. It will turn left on Center and then left on Clay Street. The parade will end at Clay and Combs.
- 11. Parade lineup begins at 4:00 pm. You will receive a map and line up number in the mail. Staff will be onsite to assist you.
- 12. If your application is not accepted for the parade your entry fee will be returned to you.
- 13. Once you or your organization is accepted into the parade there are no refunds of entry fees. No refunds of entry fees will be given for units that fail to show up or ejected from the parade.
- 14. The parade begins promptly at 5:30 pm.
- 15. Once you are on the parade route keep your unit moving. Do not stop your unit during the parade unless you are instructed to do so by a member of the committee or Collinsville Police/Fire personnel.
- 16. All drivers of motorized vehicles must be 21 years of age or older, must have a valid driver's license, and must have in their possession the day of the parade proof of insurance for the vehicle they are driving.
- 17. At the conclusion of the parade, you may park your float along Main St. in designated parking spaces and return to the Collins House for festivities.
