### **Armed Robbery**

On Sunday, 01/05/2020, at about 6:56 am, officers of the Collinsville Police Department responded to 4-0-2 Quick Shop – Exxon located at 810 S. Morrison Ave. Collinsville, IL in reference to an armed robbery that had just occurred. In the moments prior to the call for help, a black male suspect entered the business, displayed a handgun, and demanded money from the register. The store employee attempted to open the register but was interrupted by the suspect who smashed the keyboard prior to the drawer opening. The employee attempted to open a second register, however, the suspect grabbed the cashier machine from the counter and fled the store on foot.

The suspect was last seen running north west from the business toward S. Clinton Street.

The suspect is described as:

- Black male approximately 5'08"-6'0" tall; thin build. Last seen wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt, dark pants, black athletic shoes with white soles, and white colored gloves.

The suspect is considered armed and dangerous.
