About The NCS™

The National Community SurveyTM (The NCSTM) report is about the "livability" of Collinsville. A livable community is a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. It is not only where people do live, but where they want to live. The survey was developed by the experts from National Research Center at Polco.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, private sector, community-based organizations and residents, all geographically connected. The NCS captures residents' opinions considering ten central facets of a community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts, and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 366 residents of the City of Collinsville collected from March 27, 2023 to May 8, 2023. The margin of error around any reported percentage is 5% for all respondents and the response rate for the 2023 survey was 14%. Survey results were weighted so that the demographic profile of respondents was representative of the demographic profile of adults in Collinsville.





How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the "percent positive." Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data." However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC's database of comparative resident opinion is comprised of resident perspectives gathered in surveys from over 600 communities whose residents evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Community Survey. The comparison evaluations are from the most recent survey completed in each community in the last five years. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. The communities in the database represent a wide geographic and population range. In each tab, Collinsville's results are noted as being "higher" than the benchmark, "lower" than the benchmark, or "similar" to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Collinsville residents is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as "higher" or "lower" than the benchmark means that Collinsville's average rating for a particular item was more than 10 points different than the benchmark. If a rating was "much higher" or "much lower," then Collinsville's average rating was more than 20 points different when compared to the benchmark.

The survey was administered after the COVID-19 pandemic, a time of challenge for many local governments. While we provide comparisons to national benchmarks, it is important to note that much of the benchmark data was collected prior to the pandemic. This may impact how your City's 2023 ratings compare to other communities' ratings from the past five years.

Trends over time

Trend data for Collinsville represent important comparison data and should be examined for improvements or declines*. Deviations from stable trends over time represent opportunities for understanding how local policies, programs, or public information may have affected residents' opinions. Changes between survey years have been noted with an arrow and the percent difference. If the difference is greater than seven percentage points between the 2019 and 2023 surveys, the change is statistically significant.

* In 2020, The NCS survey was updated to include new and refreshed items. Consequently, some of the trends may be impacted due to wording modifications that could have potentially altered the meaning of the item for the respondent.

Methods

Selecting survey recipients

All households within the City of Collinsville were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all households within the zip codes serving Collinsville was purchased from Go-Dog Direct based on updated listings from the United States Postal Service. Since some of the zip codes that serve the City of Collinsville households may also serve addresses that lie outside of the community, the exact geographic location of each housing unit was compared to community boundaries using the most current municipal boundary file. Addresses located outside of the City of Collinsville boundaries were removed from the list of potential households to survey. From that list, addresses were randomly selected as survey recipients, with multi-family housing units (defined as those with a unit number) sampled at a rate of 5:3 compared to single family housing units.

An individual within each household was selected using the birthday method. The birthday method selects a person within the household by asking the "person whose birthday has most recently passed" to complete the questionnaire. The underlying assumption in this method is that day of birth has no relationship to the way people respond to surveys. This instruction was contained in the introduction of the survey.

Conducting the survey

The 2,800 randomly selected households received mailings beginning on March 27, 2023 and the survey remained open for six weeks. The first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained a cover letter with instructions, the survey questionnaire, and a postage-paid return envelope. All mailings included a web link to give residents the opportunity to respond to the survey online. All follow-up mailings asked those who had not completed the survey to do so and those who had already done so to refrain from completing the survey again.

About 4% of the 2,800 mailed invitations or surveys were returned because the household address was vacant or the postal service was unable to deliver the survey as addressed. Of the remaining 2,698 households that received the invitations to participate, 366 completed the survey, providing an overall response rate of 14%. The response rate was calculated using AAPOR's response rate #2 for mailed surveys of unnamed persons.*

It is customary to describe the precision of estimates made from surveys by a "level of confidence" and accompanying "confidence interval" (or margin of error). A traditional level of confidence, and the one used here, is 95%. The 95% confidence interval can be any size and quantifies the sampling error or imprecision of the survey results because some residents' opinions are relied on to estimate all residents' opinions. The margin of error for the City of Collinsville survey is no greater than plus or minus five percentage points around any given percent reported for all respondents (366 completed surveys).

In addition to the randomly selected "probability sample" of households, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Collinsville. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; respondents were asked to indicate if they lived in Collinsville and about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on April 24, 2023. The survey remained open for two weeks. The data presented in the following tabs exclude the open participation survey data, but a tab at the end provides the complete frequency of responses to questions by the open participation respondents.

Analyzing the data

Responses from mailed surveys were entered into an electronic dataset using a "key and verify" method, where all responses are entered twice and compared to each other. Any discrepancies were resolved in comparison to the original survey form. Range checks as well as other forms of quality control were also performed. Responses from surveys completed on Polco were downloaded and merged with the mailed survey responses.

The demographics of the survey respondents were compared to those found in the 2020 Census and 2022 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Collinsville. The primary objective of weighting survey data is to make the survey respondents reflective of the larger population of the community. The characteristics used for weighting were sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.

NRC aligns demographic labels with those used by the U.S. Census for reporting purposes, when possible. Some categories (e.g., age, race/Hispanic origin, housing type, and length of residency) are combined into smaller subgroups.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the "percent positive." The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating "yes" or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data". However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Key Findings

Safety continues to be the most important area of focus for Collinsville residents.

When asked about aspects of the community that the City should focus on in the next two years, residents rated safety as the most important facet of livability (94% essential or very important). Around 9 in 10 residents positively rated how safe they felt in their neighborhood during the day and in Collinsville's downtown/commercial areas during the day, in line with national averages. About 7 in 10 residents also felt safe from property and violent crime. Although most measures were on par with other communities around the country, some aspects of this facet declined in positive ratings since 2019. The quality of police/sheriff services experienced a significant decline, dropping from 89% excellent or good in 2019 to 66% in 2023. Ambulance or emergency medical services (86%), fire services (85%), and fire prevention and education (69%) also decreased by about 10% since the previous survey. These declines, as well as the lower-than-benchmark rating for overall feelings of safety, indicate a potential area of need for the City to address moving forward.

Many aspects of the local economy are in line with other communities, but residents show concern about general affordability and their own economic outlook.

Residents ranked Collinsville's overall economic health as the second-most important area of focus for the City (89% essential or very important). Overall, most measures of Collinsville's local economy were on par with other jurisdictions across the country. Around half of residents positively evaluated the variety of business and service establishments, economic development within the City, and the overall economic health of Collinsville. Additionally, 62% of residents rated the overall quality of business and service establishments as excellent or good, a statistically significant increase from 2019 survey results.

While most reviews related to Collinsville's economy were similar to the national benchmarks, results indicated that residents were less optimistic about their own personal economic outlook and the affordability of resources within the city. The cost of living in Collinsville garnered positive evaluations from less than 50% of residents. The city's employment opportunities were viewed as excellent or good by only one-quarter of respondents, a result lower than national comparisons. Additionally, the availability of affordable quality food (53% positive), affordable quality health care (44%), and affordable quality mental health care (25%) all saw significant decreases since 2019. When asked what impact the economy would likely have on their family income in the next six months, only 15% anticipated that it would be very or somewhat positive.

Collinsville's natural environment and parks and recreation system remain areas of opportunity for the City, but show signs of improvement.


The overall quality of the natural environment and the overall quality of parks and recreation opportunities in Collinsville were positively evaluated by just over half of residents, both lower than national comparisons. Collinsville's recycling (65% excellent or good) and yard waste pickup services (53%) both saw statistically significant declines since the prior survey. Roughly half of respondents favorably reviewed the city's open space and preservation of natural areas; while these held steady with previous results, open space scored lower than the national benchmark. A similar proportion gave positive marks to the availability of paths and walking trails, fitness opportunities, and recreational opportunities, all of which were lower than comparison communities. However, other areas of these facets have improved since 2019. The quality of City parks (63%), recreation programs or classes (47%), and recreation centers or facilities (50%) all saw statistically significant increases of about 10%, though each of these still rated lower than the benchmark. Despite these upward trends, the comparatively lower ratings may warrant additional attention, particularly given that at least three-quarters of respondents considered these facets to be essential or very important areas of focus in the coming years.

Facets of livability

Resident perceptions of quality and importance for each of the facets of community livability provide an overview of community strengths and challenges that are useful for planning, budgeting and performance evaluation.

The charts below show the proportion of residents who rated the community facets positively for quality and the priority (importance) placed on each. Also displayed is whether local ratings were lower, similar, or higher than communities across the country (the national benchmark).


Balancing performance and importance

Every jurisdiction must balance limited resources while meeting resident needs and striving to optimize community livability. To this end, it is helpful to know what aspects of the community are most important to residents and which they perceive as being of higher or lower quality. It is especially helpful to know when a facet of livability is considered of high importance but rated as lower quality, as this should be a top priority to address.

To help guide City staff and officials with decisions on future resource allocation, resident ratings of the importance of services were compared to their ratings of the quality of these services. To identify the services perceived by residents to have relatively lower quality at the same time as relatively higher importance, all services were ranked from highest perceived quality to lowest perceived quality and from highest perceived importance to lowest perceived importance. Some services were in the top half of both lists (higher quality and higher importance); some were in the top half of one list but the bottom half of the other (higher quality and lower importance or lower quality and higher importance); and some services were in the bottom half of both lists.


Services receiving quality ratings of excellent or good by 54% or more of respondents were considered of "higher quality" and those with ratings lower than 54% were considered to be of "lower quality." Services were classified as "more important" if they were rated as essential or very important by 73% or more of respondents. Services were rated as "less important" if they received a rating of less than 73%. This classification uses the median ratings for quality and importance to divide the services in half.

The quadrants in the figure below show which community facets were given higher or lower importance ratings (right-left) and which had higher or lower quality ratings (up-down). Facets of livability falling closer to a diagonal line from the lower left to the upper right are those where performance ratings are more commensurate with resident priorities. Facets scoring closest to the lower right hand corner of the matrix (higher in importance and lower in quality) are those that may warrant further investigation to see if changes to their delivery are necessary to improve their performance. This is the key part of this chart on which to focus. Facets falling in the top left hand corner of the chart (lower in importance but higher in quality) are areas where performance may outscore resident priorities, and may be a consideration for lower resource allocation.











Overall quality of the utility infrastructure in Collinsville, 2023













Participation in the arts, in educational opportunities, and in cultural activities is linked to increased civic engagement, greater social tolerance, and enhanced enjoyment of the local community.







Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™), the City of Collinsville conducted a survey of 2,800 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from March 27, 2023 to May 8, 2023. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Collinsville. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; respondents were asked to indicate if they lived in Collinsville and where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on April 24, 2023. The survey remained open for two weeks and there were 79 responses.

The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. Due to limited response, the results were not statistically weighted.
