

# **CBSL COACH REQUIREMENTS**

# All Volunteers must complete the following requirements BEFORE participation

Individuals that would like to volunteer will be required to complete the following documents and certifications:

- 1. Complete an Annual Background Check with the City of Collinsville
- 2. Complete online training for the CDC Concussion Protocol (valid for 3 years)
- 3. Complete the Mandated Reporter Training required by the City of Collinsville (valid for 6 years)
- 4. Complete a Volunteer Waiver Release and Indemnification Form required by the City of Collinsville
- 5. Commitment to Ethical Conduct required by the City of Collinsville
- 6. Complete the Guideline for Interacting with Minors required by the City of Collinsville

#### **Step 1: Complete Background check**

## **Step 2: CDC Concussion Protocol**

- ➤ Valid for 3 years
- You will receive a document with the CDC's "Heads up to Youth Sports" and all the specific information that you will need.
  - 1. Test—must have a passing grade of at least 80% —you will be given up to 10 opportunities to pass this test
  - 2. **Email** a copy of your certificate to the Recreation Superintendent Kristen Siebert recsuperintendent@collinsvilleil.org
- > If you already have a Concussion Protocol certification, please send a copy of the certificate to Kristen
