Top Concerns

- ◆ The neighborhood survey asked residents to identify their top concerns in their neighborhood.
- ◆ <u>Uptown</u>: Out of 61 responses, Uptown identified the top three concerns as Speeding, Roads & Sidewalks, and Unkempt Properties.
- ♠ Mulberry Hills: Out of 4 responses,
 Mulberry Hills identified the top 3
 concerns as Stormwater Drainage, Roads
 & Sidewalks and Crime.



Capital Improvement Plan


