

# A Message from the Mayor

Now that the Holiday season is quickly approaching, we can look ahead to what is happening in our great City.

The extremely popular Veteran Banners will be taken down, stored for next year, and replaced with the Holiday banners, and lighting will be installed to begin the festive seasons of Thanksgiving and Christmas.





At City Hall, work on the Veterans' Memorial at the south side of the building is being completed after Memorial Trees had to be removed for intruding into the City Hall foundation. This side of the building will now boast a nice Memorial, a new walkway and new trees.

The Collins House and Park is finished and will take on a new look for the holidays, with Uptown events and happenings planned.

Infrastructure projects are happening all around the City. New turn lanes are being installed on Beltline Road at Keebler, the Streetscape is continuing on East Main and Clay Streets, and a major water main project is underway in the Uptown in anticipation of milling and overlay early next year. After a long delay, construction will soon begin on the City's new water plant next to Rural King on Collinsville Road. The new state-of-the-art facility will replace the current 60 year old plant across the street, and should be up and running by Fall of 2019.



Construction seems to be occurring in all corners of our community. On Vandalia near Navigation Church, a new medical office building will house dozens of white collar personnel; on the Beltline a new Med Express Urgent Care, a Medical Office, and a FireHouse Subs restaurant are being built; Jimmy John's is underway on North Bluff, alongside another restaurant to be named later; Colton's Steakhouse will replace the old Ponderosa on Eastport Plaza Drive, and the old Kmart building should be coming down soon to make room for WalMart Neighborhood Market.

We are all excited about these new projects and the Holiday season approaching. I wish you and your family a very festive Thanksgiving and a very Merry Christmas. And let us all look to a positive and prosperous New Year.
