Armed Robbery

On Saturday, 3/30/2019, at about 8:20am, officers of the Collinsville Police Department responded to GCS Credit Union 1502 Vandalia in referenced to an armed robbery. As employees were arriving to work, two black male suspects, both armed with pistols, rushed into the bank as an employee was being let in and demanded money. One suspect put cash into a black duffel bag while the other suspect held employees as gunpoint. Both suspects then fled the scene on foot and departed the area in a yellow newer style Chevrolet Camaro with tinted windows. They were last seen driving westbound on Beltline Road at Keebler.

Thankfully, no one was injured.

The suspects were last seen wearing hooded sweatshirts and have been described as:

- Suspect 1: Black Male approx.. 5'08"- 5'10" thin build wearing black Adidas pants, black Nike Air shoes, black hooded sweatshirt
- Suspect 2: Black Male approx.. 5' 10" – 6'00" heavy build wearing black pants, black shoes, black hooded sweatshirt

These suspects are considered armed and dangerous.
