### Armed Robbery

On Sunday 4/14/2019 at about 2:00 PM, the Collinsville Police Department responded to US Bank, 501 Beltline Collinsville, IL, in reference to a robbery. Upon arriving, patrol officers spoke to bank employees and reviewed security footage. Initial investigation revealed the suspect stepped to the service counter of the bank and demanded money. During the conversation, the suspect lifted his jacket to reveal a handgun in his waistband. The suspect then took an undisclosed amount of US currency, put the money in a bag, and fled the scene on foot. He was last seen running northbound from the Schnuck's parking lot into a wooded area behind the business complex. No shots were fired and no one was injured during this crime.

The suspect is described as:

White male 600-605 170-190 lbs., 35-40 years of age  
He was last seen wearing a baseball style cap, sunglasses, an orange hooded sweatshirt, light blue pants, and brown work style boots.

The suspect is considered armed and dangerous.
